Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last good confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which we believe are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees completely when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and other casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass services.

We are happy to see new faces at Immaculate Conception Church, and we look forward to seeing you again!

Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass, and after Wed. & Saturday Mass.

- **BAKE SALE:** The Christian Mothers are hosting a bake sale after all three Masses next Sunday, Feb. 19 for the personal needs of the seminarians of Mater Dei Seminary in Omaha and Persia, Iowa. Free will offering!
- **SUNDAY CATECHISM** will be canceled next Sunday (during the bake sale) for the Confirmation class **only** (the class that usually meets in the parish hall.) The downstairs classes will be conducted as normal.
- **HOLY HOUR** will be at 6:00 PM on Shrove Tuesday, February 21. There will be confessions first at 5:30, and also after the holy hour if anyone does not get in before.
- **LENTEN DAY OF RECOLLECTION** with Father Benedict Hughes from Idaho will be on the morning of Saturday, March 4. It is highly recommended for all the adults and teenagers of the parish to attend!
- **CAUTION:** When standing in the vestibule, please make sure no one is standing too close to the St. Philomena shrine candles so that no one catches on fire or knocks candles over. Please supervise children at all times!
- **CHILDRENS' ACTIVITIES** on Wednesday mornings will not be held until sometime after Easter.
- **CONTACT INFO:** If you change your contact info, please take a parish registration form and place it in the slot, noting if there are changes for the parish contact information. If you are a new parishioner and have not yet filled out a form, they are on the bulletin counter in the vestibule.
- **BLESSED CANDLEMAS CANDLES** are available for a donation of at least \$8.00 per box. Write "Candlemas Candles" on envelopes on the counter and place in the slot.
