EASTER DUTY

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the USA, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

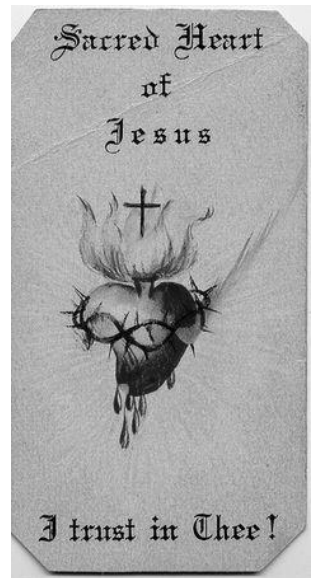
If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

We are happy to see new faces at Immaculate Conception Church, and we look forward to seeing you again!

Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass, and after each scheduled Wednesday & Saturday Mass.

- **THE BANNES OF MATRIMONY** are announced for the second time for Brandon Roelike and Katelynn Malecha. If anyone is aware of an impediment to this marriage, please notify Father Molina.
- **SUMMER EMBER DAYS** are Wednesday, Friday and Saturday of Pentecost week (May 31, June 2, and June 3). They are days of fast, with partial abstinence on Wednesday and Saturday and the usual complete abstinence on Friday.
- **CONGRATULATIONS** to all those receiving the sacrament of Confirmation today!
- Confirmandi and sponsors should be ready to come up to the Communion rail immediately after the 9:00 Mass.
- **POTLUCK** will follow each Mass today. If you are still visiting in the parish hall after the next Mass has begun, please remember to keep the doors into the parish hall closed and be quiet if going into the hallway to use the restroom. Also, if you are leaving the potluck while another Mass is going on, please exit through the lower door in the parish hall instead of going through the cry room (unless you have trouble with stairs).
- **WELCOME** to Sister Veronica Mairi, CMD from Scotland (sister of the recently ordained Fr. Caleb Armour), who has been transferred to Sartell to work at our school and parish!
- **COFFEE AND ROLLS** will be after the Masses next Sunday, June 4, so that you can meet and welcome Fr. Craig. If you have not yet sent him ordination/ welcome cards, please feel free to leave them in the slot in the vestibule counter (or give them to him in person).
- **CORPUS CHRISTI** high Mass and procession will be Sunday, June 11, at the 9:00 Mass. **NOTE! THE THIRD MASS** will begin at **11:30 on June 11.**
