EASTER DUTY -

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the USA, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to neet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

<u>Confessions</u>: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, Sunday, and Holyday Mass, and after each scheduled Wednesday & Saturday Mass.

- <u>COFFEE AND BITES</u> will be served after all the Masses today, May 7. There will be espresso coffee, regular coffee, and a bite to eat, all for a free will donation.
- <u>SCHOOL REGISTRATION DEADLINE</u>: If any parish children will be in kindergarten next year, or if you plan to send any new students to Immaculate Conception Academy, please speak with Sr. Philomena (320-333-9358) <u>today</u>, <u>May 7</u>. (To be in kindergarten next school year, children must reach their fifth birthday by Sept. 1, 2023.)
- <u>THE BANNS OF MATRIMONY</u> are announced for the third time for Jason Cook and Maddie Doroff. If anyone is aware of an impediment to this marriage, please notify one of the priests.
- <u>THE LAST SUNDAY CATECHISM CLASS</u> for this school year will be held today, May 7. (Class for the older group will be in the meeting room, and only for those receiving Confirmation this month.)
- <u>ASCENSION THURSDAY</u> is May 18. The faithful are reminded that they are bound under pain of mortal sin to attend Mass and to abstain from any unnecessary work or shopping, just as on Sundays.
- <u>LAWN & GARDEN WORK PARTY</u> will be after the morning Mass this Saturday, May 13. Contact Fr. Molina with any questions. (*Please remember he will be at ordinations on May 9 and 11.*)
- MAY FLOWERS: Feel free to bring flowers for the May shrine. Please label & claim your vases.
- HAPPY MOTHERS' DAY! The third Mass on Mothers' Day is for all mothers of our parish.
- BLESSING OF EXPECTANT MOTHERS will be upon request, on Sundays or weekdays.
- ICA SCHOOL PROGRAM will be after the 11:00 Mass on Sunday, May 21. All are welcome!
- <u>CONFESSIONS</u> are heard a few times during the week, since there is not enough time on Sundays for everyone. Please see the weekday confession times and make use of them when able.
- NOVENA FOR PENTECOST is prayed from May 19 to 27. Copies will be available on Ascension Thursday.
- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> will be after the 9:00 Mass on Sunday, May 28. Girls and ladies are encouraged to wear a white and/or red dress, if possible. White veils with red flowers will be provided for the girls to borrow. Red ties will be available for boys to borrow. You will be able to find these items before the 9:00 Mass on May 28 in the meeting room. Please plan to be very early, especially if you would like to get in line for confession!
- <u>FULL CHURCH</u>: There will be a large group of Confirmandi on May 28, and the pews in the church and cry room will be needed for their families, sponsors, and friends at the 9:00 Mass. If you are not relatives, friends, or sponsors (or families of sponsors or choir members), please try to attend the 7:00 or 11:00 Mass on May 28.

If you are still visiting in the parish hall after the next Mass has begun, please remember to keep the doors into the parish hall closed and be quiet if going into the hallway to use the restroom.
