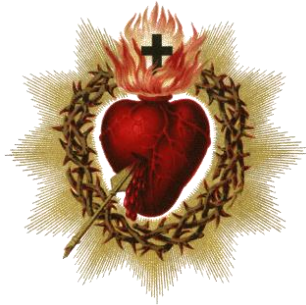

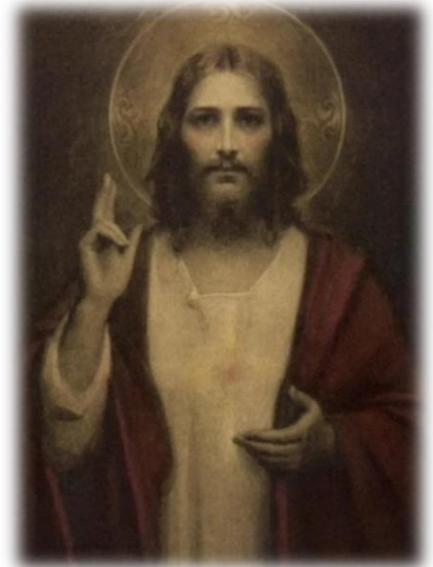

## Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.  
(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

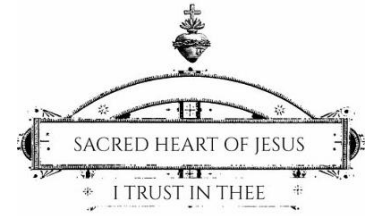
If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

**Confessions:** 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass, and after Wednesday & Saturday Mass.

- **EVENING CLASS:** There will also be **evening class at 7:00** by the bishop for teens and adults on Tuesday and Thursday. *(This will be on Tuesday and Thursday only. There will be no children's classes in the evening.)*
- **SPECIALTY COFFEE AND BITES** will be served after the 8:00 Mass for those staying for the bishop's class on Friday, June 23, and will also be served after the 7:00 and 9:00 Masses on Sunday, June 25.
- **FIRST COMMUNICANTS:** For all parish children who will be in second grade this coming school year and who are not enrolled in Immaculate Conception Academy, please contact Sr. Anne Marie ASAP in order to be ready for this coming year's first Communion class. (Cell- 320- 333-0123)
- **CHRISTIAN MODESTY:** Remember Our Lady's warning about immodest fashions. We should always be careful to give a good example by our modesty in dress and demeanor, no matter how hot the weather. Ladies and girls must be especially careful that their tops are not low cut, and should never approach the communion rail unless properly covered. Also, clothing should not be too tight, and skirts must cover the knees when sitting and standing.
