Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

<u>Confessions</u>: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass, and after each scheduled Wednesday & Saturday Mass.

<u>EASTER DUTY</u> All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the USA, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (which is today).

- <u>SPECIAL COLLECTION</u> for St. Joseph Minor Seminary in Idaho is this Sunday, June 4. If you do not have tithing envelopes, you may use the second collection envelopes with red borders in the vestibule. You may drop them in the collection basket or the slot in the counter. Write checks out to St. Joseph Minor Seminary. Thank you!
- TAX LETTERS! Please make note! If you will be wanting tax letters for any of the summer special collections, please contact the places to which you are making the checks out directly, as the parish here cannot provide tax letters for donations to other places. You may find their addresses on their websites. Links to their websites can be found on the "Traditional Catholic Resources" tab of our parish website.
- **RETREAT:** Please avoid contacting any of the CMD sisters while they are on retreat from **June 6 to 8**. Thank you!
- <u>SUMMER CATECHISM</u> will be Monday through Friday, June 19 23, from after the 8:00 AM Mass until noon. There will be classes for children age 5 and older, as well as classes by Bishop Pivarunas for high school and adults.
- <u>PLEASE SIGN-UP</u> children in grade school on the sheet in the vestibule today, or at least **by next Sunday**, **June 11**, so that the visiting sisters can prepare.

<u>PLEASE REVIEW!</u> Here are a few general information announcements, especially for the sake of new parishioners. (More next Sunday...)

- <u>SUNDAY BULLETINS</u> are posted on our website (usually by the preceding Saturday evening). If you have a smart phone, you could add the bulletin tab of our website to your home screen. If you ever miss a Sunday Mass or forget to pick up a bulletin, please read the bulletin online so that you do not miss any important announcements.
- <u>CONTACT</u>: Please remember that cell phones are the best way for parishioners to contact the priests or sisters, as the landline messages are not checked as frequently. The priests' **contact information** is at the top of each bulletin.
- <u>CHURCH LIBRARY</u> is in the room off the vestibule. Besides many books, CDs, and periodicals to check out, there is also a shelf of books and religious items for sale (the overflow from the counter in the vestibule.) Please place payment for any books and religious articles from the vestibule counter or the library "for sale" shelf into the vestibule slot. No need to use up a miscellaneous envelope, since all loose cash in the slot should be for books and religious articles.
- MARY IMMACULATE QUEEN CENTER: If you can't find a book or religious item in our small bookstore, please check out MIQCenter in Spokane. There is a link to their online store in the Traditional Catholic Resources tab on our website.
- <u>VESTIBULE SLOT</u>: The money slot is on the left side of the bulletin counter. You may use it if you miss the collection basket, or to pay for anything from the vestibule, or to leave anything for the priests or sisters. Please be sure that everything is labeled unless it is just cash to pay for a purchase from the vestibule. (The only thing that should NOT go in the counter slot is money for vigil candles, which should go in slots at any of the candle racks.)
- <u>CRY ROOM</u>: During Mass, please treat the vestibule as the cry room, and thus as part of the church. Please do not attend Mass in the cry room unless you have young children who need to be there. We have a large spacious cry room, but since we have so many young children, it is important to leave room for the parents and children who need to be there.
- Out of respect for the parents attending Mass in the cry room, please bring crying or very noisy children down the hallway into Becket Hall. The cry room is for the small noises that would be distracting inside the church, but the louder noises need to be brought down to the parish hall to help keep the spirit of prayer in the cry room. Also,

loud noises carry right through the glass into the church.

- NO FOOD ALLOWED in the church or cry room. If you would like to give your children food at church, please bring them to a table in the parish hall. Thank you for helping to keep proper decorum and tidiness in God's house!
- <u>BLESSING OF EXPECTANT MOTHERS</u> is upon request.
 Please contact a priest if you would like the blessing on any day of the week.
- <u>BLESSING OF RELIGIOUS ARTICLES</u>: If you have items to be blessed, please bring them in a labeled box or bag and place them on the table next to the rectory, and Father will bless them during the week. You may then claim them when they are put on the lost and found counter in the hallway.
