## Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

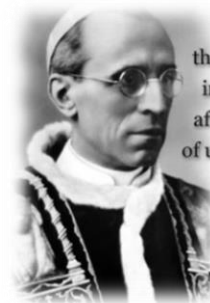
(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

**Confessions:** 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass, and after Wednesday & Saturday Mass.

- **THE FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION**, August 15, is a holyday of obligation. The faithful are reminded that they are bound under pain of mortal sin to attend Mass and to abstain from any unnecessary servile work or shopping, just as on Sundays.

- **PARISH PRESCHOOL:** Some parishioners have kindly volunteered to run a more structured preschool open to all parish families this coming school year, beginning on Sept. 11, 2023. Here is a brief overview:
- Welcome to the 2023/2024 Immaculate Conception Preschool! We hope that all the children that attend will not only grow in their knowledge of beginner learning skills, but also in their Faith. We strive to create an environment that not only nourishes the young heart but allows them to learn structure and also create friendships within the parish.
- Classes will be held in the parish hall every Monday and Thursday, from 1:00 to 3:00 PM. If your child is over the age of 4 and potty trained, they may be dropped off for preschool. If they are under the age of 4 or not potty trained quite yet, they can still come and enjoy class with their parent's assistance.
- There is no need to commit to the whole year, but we ask that parents "RSVP" their child to class each week so that we can be sure to have enough supplies. Classes are free, but anyone is welcome to give donations to help purchase supplies.
