

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

• A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,

• Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

• Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.

Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

We are happy to see new faces at Immaculate Conception Church, and we look forward to seeing you again!

<u>Confessions</u>: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; during or after the 8:00 Wednesday Mass; and after Saturday Mass.

- HOLY HOUR will be at 6 PM this Tuesday, August 22, feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
- <u>NOTE</u>: There are two public Masses scheduled on Wednesday, to give the faithful a chance to attend an early Mass before work. Also, confessions will usually be during instead of after the 8:00 Mass.
- <u>TARCISIANS of the SACRED HEART</u> is a society named after St. Tarcisius (the boy martyr of the Holy Eucharist) which was started by Fr. Mateo in 1917. Its purpose is to group Catholic children into a zealous band of apostles for the reign of the Sacred Heart in homes and in society. We will be starting this society here for parish children of grade school age. We will meet for about a half hour on First Fridays after either 8:00 AM Mass or distribution of Holy Communion, starting Sept. 1. If you and your children are interested, you may listen to the podcast on this group found on the "For Parents" playlist of the Catholic Family Podcast. More details will be in the next bulletin.
