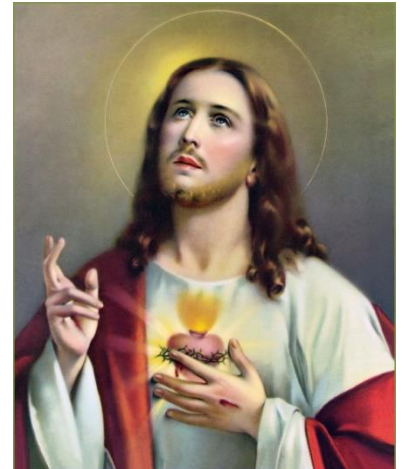

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

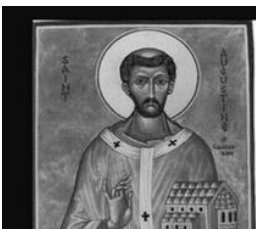
(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; during or after the 8:00 Wednesday Mass; and after Saturday Mass.

- **CONGRATULATIONS** to Mr. and Mrs. Nathan and Anna Ruegemer, who have been joined in holy matrimony!
- **TARCISIANS of the SACRED HEART** is a society started by Fr. Mateo in 1917. Its purpose is to group Catholic children into a band of apostles for the reign of the Sacred Heart in homes and in society. We will be starting this society here for parish children of grade school age. We will meet for about a half hour on First Friday morning after distribution of Holy Communion and Benediction, starting this Friday, Sept. 1. Children may pack a breakfast to eat after Communion and Benediction. The meeting will begin after they finish breakfast, and last about a half hour. If you have children who are interested in joining, you may take a pamphlet to read more. Also, the Catholic Family Podcast has an episode explaining the group. Please ask Fr. Molina if you have further questions. If your children would like to join, you may simply bring them this Friday morning, and we will make a list of children's names so that we can make badges for them and be prepared for them to be enrolled the following month.
- **FIRST FRIDAY:** If you wish to make your nine first Fridays, one of the requirements is to receive Holy Communion on the first Friday of nine consecutive months, with the intention of reparation to the Sacred Heart. There will now be Communion in the mornings, to make it easier for more people to make the nine first Fridays.
- **PARISH PRESCHOOL** begins Mon., Sept. 11, from 1 to 3 PM. Please contact Ashley Tucker **ASAP** if interested.
- **POTLUCK PARISH PICNIC** and corn hole contest will be on Sunday, September 10, around the block from our church at Northside Park. Water coolers, cups, and paper products will be provided. Please bring food to share!
- **SUNDAY CATECHISM** classes for parish children in Kindergarten through 8th grade who do not attend ICA will resume on September 17, starting around 8:15 (between the first and second Masses).
- **HARVEST FESTIVAL** at St. Joseph's Church in Harmony, MN will be Saturday, September 30, beginning with High Mass at 11:00 AM. Please see the flyer and agenda posted on the bulletin board for more details. Our parishioners are cordially invited to join our neighbor parish for this enjoyable event.
