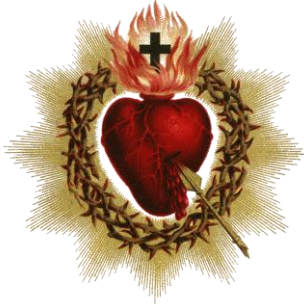

## Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

*(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)*

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

**Confessions:** 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; during or after the 8:00 Wednesday Mass; and after Saturday Mass.

- **OCTOBER ROSARY WITH EXPOSITION:** On Tuesdays through Fridays, there is rosary with simple Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:30 AM.
- **CHURCH LIBRARY** will be closed for heaven house set-up from October 23 to 31. If you would like to return or check out any books, or to purchase any items from the "for sale" shelves inside the library, please do so soon.
- **MISSION SUNDAY** is next Sunday, October 22. Pope Pius XI designated the second last Sunday of October as Mission Sunday, a day for Catholics to pray for and contribute donations to the foreign missions. The red bordered envelopes in the vestibule are for special donations, if anyone would like to make a contribution to the mission fund. Please clearly mark the envelope "**For the Missions.**" *Any checks should be made out to "Immaculate Conception Church."* Please also keep the foreign missions in your prayers.
- **POTLUCK, SILENT AUCTION, & HEAVEN HOUSE** will be held on October 29. The potluck will be after all three Masses. The heaven house will be after the 7:00 and 9:00 Masses. Bidding for the auction will end at 10:45. So, those attending the 11:00 Mass will need to arrive by 10:00 in order to see the heaven house. You may also arrive early to bid at the silent auction before the 11:00 Mass. If you are not still around when the bidding ends at 10:45, please check the parish hall when you come back for Mass on All Saints' Day so that you can see if you have items to pick up and pay for. (Winners will not be individually contacted, so please check!)
- **SILENT AUCTION** on October 29 will be a fundraiser for the CMD sisters in our parish. If you have any items you would like to donate for the auction, you may bring them to the meeting room **no later than next Sunday, October 22.** Thank you for your kind donations, and God bless you!
- **ALL SAINTS' DAY PARTY** will be from 1:00 to 3:00 PM on Tuesday, October 31. All children of the parish are invited to join the ICA students in Becket Hall!
- **PREPARATION FOR TOTAL CONSECRATION:** St. Louis De Montfort's Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary has been highly recommended by many popes. Those wishing to make this consecration for the first time on Dec. 8, feast of the Immaculate Conception, must prepare four weeks in advance according to the form set down by St. Louis de Montfort. Preparation begins on Nov. 5. Please read the book *True Devotion* before November 5 if you will prepare to make this consecration on December 8.
