#### Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You should also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing are not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

- HOLY HOUR for October will be at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, October 11, feast of the Divine Maternity.
- ROSARY PROCESSION will be at 6:00 PM this Friday, October 13. (You may pray on your own in church if unable to walk outside.)
- GAME NIGHT for families and individuals of all ages will be after the procession on Friday, October 13. Bring your favorite games to share! Feel free to bring finger food snacks.
- <u>HOLY LAND PILGRIMAGE</u> in May 2024 is being arranged by Fr. Benedict Hughes. Please see the brochure in the vestibule if you are interested.
- <u>ICA RUN-A-THON</u> will be on Saturday, October 21 at 11 AM at Riverview Intermediate. You may help raise money for the new playset by sponsoring students and/or the priests.
- POTLUCK, SILENT AUCTION, & HEAVEN HOUSE will be held on October 29. The potluck will be after all three Masses. The heaven house will be after the 7:00 and 9:00 Masses. Bidding for the auction will end at 10:45. So, those attending the 11:00 Mass will need to arrive by 10:00 in order to see the heaven house. You may also arrive early to bid at the silent auction before the 11:00 Mass. If you are not still around when the bidding ends at 10:45, please check the parish hall when you come back for Mass on All Saints' Day so that you can see if you have items to pick up and pay for. (Winners who belong to the parish will not be individually contacted, so please check!)
- <u>BLESSING OF EXPECTANT MOTHERS</u> will be given upon request. Feel free to contact one of the priests.
- <u>ALL SAINTS' DAY PARTY</u> will be from 1:00 to 3:00 PM on Tuesday, October 31. All children of the parish are invited to join the ICA students in Becket Hall!
- FEAST OF THE DIVINE MATERNITY is October 11. Please pray for the seminarians of Mater Dei Seminary and the Sisters of the Congregation of the Mother of God (CMD Sisters), whose patronal feast this is.

There is no Sunday Catechism class on October 8 & 29.

- PREPARATION FOR TOTAL CONSECRATION: St. Louis De Montfort's Total Consecration to Jesus through Mary has been highly recommended by many popes. Those wishing to make this consecration for the first time on December 8, feast of the Immaculate Conception, must prepare four weeks in advance according to the form set down by St. Louis de Montfort. Preparation begins on November 5.
- TRUE DEVOTION: Please read the book *True Devotion* before November 5 if you will be preparing to make this consecration on December 8. This book which explains the consecration is available to purchase, as well as preparation prayer booklets. Both books are also available to borrow in the parish library. You may ask Father if you have questions.
