*** EASTER DUTY ***

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the United States, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for attendance at church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

We are happy to see new faces at Immaculate Conception Church, and we look forward to seeing you again!

- **MASS SCHEDULE:** Please note that Mass this Wednesday and Thursday will be at 6:30 AM.
- **CONFIRMATION:** If any adult parishioners were confirmed in the Vatican II church around 1973 or after, and you have not yet been conditionally confirmed in the traditional rite, you may be conditionally confirmed on May 26. Please sign up ASAP, using the forms in the vestibule.
- **PHILIPPINE MISSION:** Fr. Molina will be on mission in the Philippines until the second week of May.
- **PLEASE do not** try to contact Fr. Molina while he is out of the country, as it will put a charge on his phone bill (and yours). You may direct all questions to Fr. Craig. (There will be a visiting priest coming to cover Sunday Masses in Sartell, since Father Craig will be covering other parishes on Sunday.)
- **PARISH HALL FLOOR PROJECT** is underway, so today's **catechism class** for the older students will be in the meeting room. Sr. Philomena's class today will ONLY be for those preparing for Confirmation this May. The younger groups will have class downstairs as usual. (Use only the front stairs this weekend.)
- **MEN'S GROUP** will meet this Saturday, April 20, at Dan Kramer's house. See flyer on bulletin board for more info. There is also a form you may fill out and place in the slot if you would like to be added to the men's email list.
- **HOLY HOUR** for April, the month of the Blessed Sacrament, will be at 6:00 PM on Wednesday, April 24.
- **ROSARY & FAMILY GAME NIGHT:** Friday, April 26, is the feast of Our Lady of Good Counsel. At 6:00 PM, there will be Rosary with Exposition and Benediction, followed by games in the parish hall. Bring your favorite board games to share! You may also bring finger-food snacks to share if you wish.
- **ICA 25TH ANNIVERSARY** was on January 6, 2024 (the first day of school when Immaculate Conception Academy was opened). As an anniversary celebration, there will be a potluck after the 9:00 Mass on Sunday, June 9 for all those who have ever attended or currently attend our parish school, as well as their families, and all past and current teachers. If any parishioners have relatives or friends who have moved away and who have been part of ICA, please help spread the word to them that they are all invited!
- **SUNDAY CATECHISM CLASSES** will be held for the rest of April, and then conclude for the school year.
- **SUMMER CATECHISM** will be Monday through Friday, June 10 - 14, from after the 8:00 AM Mass until noon. There will be classes taught by visiting sisters for children age 5 and older, as well as classes by Bishop Pivarunas for high school and adults. All parish children who do not attend our Catholic school should attend if at all possible. It is also highly encouraged for the teens and adults of the parish to take advantage of the free classes generously given by our busy bishop.
