

## Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.



## Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; after the 8:00 Wednesday Mass and after Saturday Mass.

- ST. LOUIS DE MONTFORT'S FEAST DAY is April 28. Those who have made Total Consecration may gain a plenary indulgence by renewing it today. If you don't have the prayer, there are copies to borrow by the bulletins.
- TARCISIANS will meet in the parish hall for the last time this school year this Friday, May 3 (after the 8 AM distribution of Holy Communion and the usual fifteen-minute thanksgiving after Communion.)
- CONFRATERNITY OF CHRISTIAN MOTHERS will meet after Mass this Saturday, May 4. All parish ladies are welcome! Feel free to bring breakfast food to share. We will be learning how to make plastic corded rosaries. We will also be having a brief discussion on the life of St. Monica, if you'd like to read a little about her ahead of time.
- **PHILIPPINE MISSION**: Please pray for Fr. Molina, who will be on mission until the second week of May.
- <u>PLEASE</u> do not try to contact Fr. Molina while he is out of the country, as it will put a charge on his phone bill (and yours). You may direct all questions to Fr. Craig.
- ICA 25<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY was on January 6, 2024 (the first day of school when Immaculate Conception Academy was opened). As an anniversary celebration, there will be a potluck after the 9:00 Mass on Sunday, June 9 for all those who have ever attended or currently attend our parish school, as well as their families, and all past and current teachers. If any parishioners have relatives or friends who have moved away and who have been part of ICA, please help spread the word to them that they are all invited!
- **SUNDAY CATECHISM CLASSES** will be held today for the last time this school year.
- **SUMMER CAMP** forms are available in the vestibule.
- **SUMMER CATECHISM** will be Monday through Friday, June 10 - 14, from after the 8:00 AM Mass until noon. There will be classes taught by visiting sisters for children age 5 and older, as well as classes by Bishop Pivarunas for high school and adults. All parish children who do not attend our Catholic school should attend if at all possible. It is also highly encouraged for the teens and adults of the parish!
- **EASTER DUTY:** All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the United States, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).
