Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

• A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,

• Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:


• Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.

• Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

- <u>MOTHERS' DAY</u>: At the beginning of the 9:00 Mass today, mothers or grandmothers with young children may bring flowers up to Our Lady's May shrine during the hymn Immaculate Mary, when Father comes out of the sacristy. If your vases do not all fit at the May shrine, the servers can help place them on Our Lady's altar. Please come up the right side aisle, and go back to your places through the middle of the church.
- **<u>HAPPY MOTHERS' DAY</u>**! The third Mass on Mothers' Day is for all mothers of our parish.
- **<u>BLESSING OF EXPECTANT MOTHERS</u>** will be upon request, any day of the week.

- **FAST DAY!** This Saturday, May 18, is the Vigil of Pentecost, a day of fast (for age 21-59) and partial abstinence (7 & older).

- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> will be after the 9:00 Mass on Sunday, May 26. Girls and ladies are encouraged to wear a white and/or red dress, if possible. White veils with red flowers will be provided for the girls to borrow. Red ties will be available for boys to borrow. You will be able to find these items before the 9:00 Mass on May 26 in the meeting room. Please plan to be very early, especially if you would like to get in line for confession!
- <u>POTLUCK</u> on May 26 will be after all three Masses, and there will also be Confirmation cake after the Confirmation ceremonies following the 9:00 Mass.
- <u>25TH ANNIVERSARY OF ICA</u> is this year. As an anniversary celebration, there will be a potluck on Sunday, June 9 (beginning after the 9:00 Mass and continuing after the 11:00 Mass) for all those who have ever been a part of our parish school, as well as their families!
