

EASTER DUTY

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the USA, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).

Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; after the 8:00 Wednesday Mass and after Saturday Mass.

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

We are happy to see new faces at Immaculate Conception Church, and we look forward to seeing you again!



• <u>SUMMER EMBER DAYS</u> are Wednesday, Friday and Saturday of Pentecost week (May 22, 24, & 25). They are days of fast for those age 21 - 59, with partial abstinence on Wednesday and Saturday and the usual complete abstinence on Friday for those seven and older.



- ICA GRADUATION will be after the 11:00 Mass today, May 19. All are welcome!
- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> will be after the 9:00 Mass next Sunday, May 26. Girls and ladies are encouraged to wear a white and/or red dress, if possible. White veils with red flowers will be provided for the girls to borrow, and red ties will be available for boys to borrow. You will be able to find these items before the 9:00 Mass on May 26 in the meeting room. Please return them to the meeting room after pictures. Plan to be very early, especially if you would like to get in line for confession!
- The front pew on each side will be reserved for those confirmandi and sponsors who would like to sit up front. All confirmandi and sponsors should be ready to come up to the Communion rail immediately after the 9:00 Mass.
- <u>POTLUCK</u> on May 26 will be after all three Masses, and there will also be Confirmation cake after the Confirmation ceremonies following the 9:00 Mass.
- <u>CONFESSIONS</u> are heard multiple times during the week, since there is not enough time on Sundays for everyone to get in. Please see the weekday confession times and make use of them when able.
- HOLY HOUR for May will be on Thursday, May 30, the feast of Corpus Christi ("Body of Christ.")
- <u>CORPUS CHRISTI</u> high Mass and procession will be Sunday, June 2, at the 9:00 Mass. **NOTE! THE THIRD** MASS will begin at <u>11:30 on June 2</u>.
- FREE OLD PIANO is available if you can move it. Please ask Sr. Philomena for more details.
- <u>25TH ANNIVERSARY OF ICA</u> is this year. As an anniversary celebration, there will be a potluck on Sunday, June 9 (beginning after the 9:00 Mass and continuing after the 11:00 Mass) for all those who have ever been a part of our parish school, as well as their families! There will be an opportunity to visit with other school families (including those of past years), to look at old school pictures, to see the classrooms downstairs, and to visit with Father Brendan!
- **GROUP PICTURE** of all current and past ICA students who can make it to the party on June 9 will be taken between the 9:00 and 11:00 Masses in the parish hall.
