#### Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

  (Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

# **EASTER DUTY**

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the USA, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday.

- <u>CONGRATULATIONS</u> to all those receiving the sacrament of Confirmation today!
- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> is after the 9:00 Mass today. White veils with red flowers are provided for the girls to borrow, and red ties will be available for boys to borrow. You will be able to find these items before the 9:00 Mass in the meeting room. Please return them to the meeting room after pictures.
- The front pew on each side will be reserved for those confirmandi and sponsors who would like to sit up front. All confirmandi and sponsors should be ready to come up to the Communion rail immediately after the 9:00 Mass.
- <u>POTLUCK</u> today is after all three Masses, and there will also be Confirmation cake after the Confirmation ceremonies following the 9:00 Mass. If you are still visiting in the parish hall after the next Mass has begun, please remember to keep the doors into the parish hall closed and be quiet if going into the hallway to use the restroom. Also, if you are leaving the potluck while another Mass is going on, please exit through the lower door in the parish hall instead of going through the cry room (unless you have trouble with stairs).
- <u>PLEASE</u> Please do not contact the sisters while they are on retreat this week. Thank you very much.
- HOLY HOUR for May will be this Thursday, May 30, the feast of Corpus Christi ("Body of Christ.")
- <u>CORPUS CHRISTI</u> high Mass and procession will be next Sunday, June 2, at the 9:00 Mass. **NOTE! THE THIRD** MASS will begin at <u>11:30 on June 2</u>.
- **SUMMER CATECHISM** will be Monday through Friday, June 10 14, from after the 8:00 AM Mass until noon.
- <u>PLEASE SIGN-UP</u> children from Kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade on the sheet in the vestibule so that the visiting sisters can prepare. (High school and adults will be in the parish hall for the bishop's classes.)
