



EASTER DUTY -

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the USA, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).

Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; after the 8:00 Wednesday Mass and after Saturday Mass.

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

- ASCENSION THURSDAY is May 9. The faithful are reminded that they are bound under pain of mortal sin to attend Mass and to abstain from any unnecessary work or shopping, just as on Sundays.
- <u>NOVENA FOR PENTECOST</u> is prayed from May 10 to 18. Copies will be available on Ascension Thursday, and there will also be a PDF posted on the bulletin tab.
- <u>PLEASE PRAY</u> for the repose of the soul of Rick Winczewski, who passed away this past week. His funeral will be on Monday, May 13. Please see the website for the Schuller Family Funeral Home in Wadena for details later in the week. Sincere condolences and assurance of prayers to his family!
- MOTHERS' DAY: Next Sunday, Mothers' Day, at the beginning of the 9:00 Mass, mothers and young children may bring flowers up to Our Lady's May shrine during the hymn Immaculate Mary, when Father comes out of the sacristy. If your vases do not all fit at the May shrine, the servers can help place them on Our Lady's altar. Please come up the right side aisle, and go back to your places through the middle of the church.
- <u>GIRLS AND BOYS CAMP</u> dates are in the box of upcoming events below. Registration forms are available in the vestibule. Please mail the registration as soon as possible to the addresses on the forms.
- PLEASE PRAY for the seminarians who will be advancing in steps towards the priesthood in Omaha on May 11.
- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> will be after the 9:00 Mass on Sunday, May 26. Girls and ladies are encouraged to wear a white and/or red dress, if possible. White veils with red flowers will be provided for the girls to borrow. Red ties will be available for boys to borrow. You will be able to find these items before the 9:00 Mass on May 26 in the meeting room. Please plan to be very early, especially if you would like to get in line for confession!
