Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last good confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

- **POTLUCK PARISH PICNIC** and corn hole contest will be next Sunday, September 8, around the block from our church at Northside Park. Water coolers, cups, and paper products will be provided. Please bring food to share!
- **CONFRATERNITY OF CHRISTIAN MOTHERS ENROLLMENT** will be Sept. 15. Any ladies who would like to be enrolled must notify LuAnn Bedel (320-761-1720 or luannbedel@hotmail.com) **by Sept. 8**. The enrollment will take place immediately **after 1st Mass** and, therefore, those who wish to be enrolled need to be at church **by 8:00 am**.
- **FIRST SATURDAY** this month, there will be no public Mass, but there will be the usual rosary during confessions at 7:30 AM, and Holy Communion will be distributed at 8:00 AM.
- **CMRI CONFRATERNITY MEETING** for September will be on the *third* Saturday of the month, Sept. 21.
- **YOUNG ADULT PARTY** for parishioners and visitors from our neighboring parishes (age 16 through 30's) will be at the Goering's residence in Clearwater, MN on Sunday, September 22, from 2 PM to around 9 PM. Please contact Father Craig or Sr. Philomena **by September 8** to RSVP and for more details.
- **CONTACT FIRST:** If coming to church outside of scheduled Mass or event times (whether to clean the church or make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament), parishioners are very welcome to come (before 7 PM). But please contact one of the priests or sisters ahead of time to make sure someone will be available to let you in when you arrive, and to make sure that there will be no baptism, wedding, etc. occurring at that time.
- **SUNDAY CATECHISM** classes for parish children in Kindergarten through 8th grade who do not attend ICA will resume on September 15, starting around 8:15 (between the first and second Masses).
- **TITHING ENVELOPES:** Please notify Sr. Anne Marie **by today** by placing a note in the vestibule slot if you would like the weekly tithing envelopes boxed set for 2025, *if you did not use them this year*. A boxed set will automatically be ordered for all those who *have been* using them **regularly (weekly)**. You may let us know if you want them for the first time, or if you want to stop getting them, by placing a note in the vestibule slot. **NOTE: Please do not request a box of the weekly envelopes if you will not use them regularly (weekly).**
- **TARCISIANS of the SACRED HEART** is a society named after St. Tarcisius (the boy martyr of the Holy Eucharist) and started by Fr. Mateo in 1917. Its purpose is to group Catholic children into a band of apostles for the reign of the Sacred Heart in homes and in society. Our monthly Tarcisian activities for parish children of grade school age will resume on first Fridays during the school year.
- We will meet for about a half hour on First Friday morning after distribution of Holy Communion. All should stay in church for a fifteen-minute thanksgiving after receiving Holy Communion, as always. Then the children may go into the parish hall (or the school children to their classrooms) to eat a packed breakfast. The meeting will begin soon after they finish breakfast, and last about a half hour. Please ask Fr. Molina if you have further questions.
- If your children would like to join for the first time, you may bring them this Friday morning, and we will make a list of children's names to order badges for them and to be prepared for them to be enrolled the following month.
- Those who are Tarcisians, try to remember to wear your badges to church on first Fridays and Sundays!
