Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last good confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

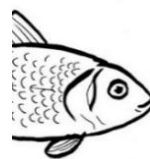

 - If your family is attending the 9:00 Mass, please arrive before 8:15 so that your children can be here for the beginning of class and not miss any important material, especially those who are preparing for sacraments.
- **FATHER MOLINA** will be away this whole week covering Masses in Florida, so please contact Father Craig for any emergency sick calls.
- **CMRI CONFRATERNITY MEETING** for September will be this Saturday, Sept. 21.
- **ST. JOSEPH MENS' GROUP** will meet in Becket Hall after the 9:00 AM Mass next Sunday, September 22. Join us for a potluck breakfast, visiting, conversation, and roundtable discussion.
- **EMBER WEEK** for autumn is this week. Wednesday and Saturday are days of partial abstinence (meat only once) for all Catholics age seven and older. (Friday is a day of complete abstinence, as usual.) Those who are 21 to 59 years of age are obliged to follow the laws of fast this Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday, just like on days of Lent.
- **RUN-A-THON** will be on Saturday, Sept. 28, at 11 AM (at the track at Riverview Intermediate School in Sartell.) Besides sponsoring school students who will be collecting pledges for running laps, you are encouraged to sponsor Fr. Molina & Fr. Craig. There are forms in the vestibule for pledging the priests. - **OUTDOOR ROSARY PROCESSION** will be after the first Friday 8 AM distribution of Holy Communion on October 4 (after the fifteen-minute thanksgiving after Communion).
