Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last good confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.
(*Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.*)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

We are happy to see new faces at Immaculate Conception Church, and we look forward to seeing you again!

Confessions: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; after or during the 8:00 Wednesday Mass; and after Saturday Mass.

- **NOTE** that there will be Mass this Monday, but **NOT** this Thursday or Friday.
- **ST. JOSEPH MENS' GROUP** will meet in Becket Hall after the 9:00 AM Mass today. Join us for a potluck breakfast, visiting, conversation, and roundtable discussion.
- **SUNDAY CATECHISM** classes for children who do not attend ICA start around 8:15, between the first and second Masses. (*Note: Classes will not be held on Oct. 13 or Oct. 27.*)
- Children in **K, 1st, 2nd and 3rd** grade should go to the large, east basement classroom with Sr. Anne Marie.
- Children in **4th grade through high school** should gather with Sr. Philomena in Becket Hall.
- (*NOTE: Sr. Philomena's class is not only for those preparing for Confirmation, but covers general topics which are useful for any age. High schoolers are also encouraged to attend.*)
- **RUN-A-THON** will be this Saturday, Sept. 28, at 11 AM (at the track at Riverview Intermediate School in Sartell.) Besides sponsoring school students who will be collecting pledges for running laps, you are encouraged to sponsor Fr. Molina & Fr. Craig. There are forms in the vestibule for pledging the priests. Thank you for your support!
- **OUTDOOR ROSARY PROCESSION** will be after the first Friday 8 AM distribution of Holy Communion on October 4 (after the fifteen-minute thanksgiving after Communion).
- **TARCISIAN ENROLLMENT** of new members will be on first Friday, Oct. 4. The parents of the Tarcisians are encouraged to bring a potluck breakfast to share with the other Tarcisians & school children. After the rosary procession, the students & Tarcisians will eat breakfast in the parish hall and then have the enrollment ceremony.
- **HARVEST FESTIVAL** at St. Joseph's Church in Harmony will be Saturday, October 19, beginning at 11:00 AM. Please see the flyer and agenda posted on the bulletin board in Becket Hall for more details and for the cooking contest rules. Our parishioners are cordially invited to join our neighbor parish for this enjoyable event.
