

Welcome To Newcomers!

We gladly welcome visitors and newcomers. At the same time, we respectfully remind them that to receive Our Lord in Holy Communion, one must be:

- A baptized Catholic, free from any mortal sin committed since one's last good confession,
- Fasting for three hours from any food and alcoholic drink and one hour from any other drink except water.

(Unless you have been attending the traditional Latin Mass exclusively, you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion until you have had an opportunity to meet with one of the priests.)

If this is the first time you have attended the Traditional Latin Mass, you may have noticed that our parishioners do not dress casually in church. Before the changes in the Church, Catholic parishes had standards for modest and appropriate attire, which are important both for the edification of others and out of respect for the house of God. Please observe these standards of dress for church:

- Women and girls must cover their heads. If you do not have a hat or veil, you may borrow a veil from the vestibule. You must also wear dresses or skirts that cover the knees when standing or sitting. Pants, shorts, sleeveless, tight or low-cut clothing not permitted.
- Men and boys should wear a dress shirt and dress pants. Jeans, shorts, and casual attire are not appropriate for attendance at Mass.

<u>Confessions</u>: 30 minutes before each scheduled Friday, Saturday, & Sunday Mass; *before* or during the 8:00 Wednesday Mass; and after Saturday Mass.

- NOTE that there is no Mass this Tuesday.
- <u>CONFESSION TIME</u> for Wednesday has changed. When there are two priests in Sartell (which you will know is the case if two Masses are scheduled on a Wednesday), Confessions will still be *during* the 8:00 Mass. But when there is only one priest, confessions will be **before** Mass instead of after Mass.
- (There is still the opportunity to go to confession *after* Mass on Saturdays if everyone does not get in before Mass.)
- <u>RUN-A-THON</u>: If you gave a pledge per lap for the priests, Fr. Molina ran 18 laps, and Fr. Craig ran 24 laps. Congratulations to Eli Swanson (26 laps), Veronica Lauer & Oliver Rabbie (24 laps) and Peyton Braun (23 laps)! Thank you very much for your support of our school!
- <u>OUTDOOR ROSARY PROCESSION</u> will be after the first Friday 8 AM distribution of Holy Communion this Friday, October 4 (after the fifteen-minute thanksgiving after Communion).
- <u>TARCISIAN ENROLLMENT</u> of new members will be this Friday, Oct. 4. The parents of the Tarcisians were sent an email with more details.
- <u>BLESSING OF CHILDREN</u> for "Angel Sunday" will be after all three Masses next Sunday, October 6. Children (and parents holding babies) may come up to kneel at or near the communion rail for the blessing right after Mass.
- OCTOBER ROSARY WITH EXPOSITION: *This Wednesday and Thursday*, there will be rosary with simple Exposition and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 7:30 AM.
- Please remember to double genuflect (kneel on both knees and bow) if you come into church when the tabernacle door is open or when the Blessed Sacrament is exposed.
- <u>LITANY OF LORETO & PRAYER TO ST. JOSEPH</u> for October are prayed after the rosary. There are paper copies in the vestibule if you would like to take them home.
- ADULT SAINT COSTUME PARTY Friday, Oct. 25, at 6 PM Potluck! This party is not only for singles (starting at age 16), but also for married couples of any age. (No RSVP needed, but check with Father before inviting anyone from outside the parish.) Simply wear a costume of a saint and be prepared to give a few facts about your saint so that others can guess who you are. Then there will be a few games for the whole group, after which you may stay longer to play more games and socialize if you wish.
- <u>CHILDREN'S ALL SAINTS' DAY PARTY</u> will be from 1:00 to 3:00 PM on Thursday, Oct. 31. All children of the parish are invited to join the ICA students in Becket Hall! Please wear a saint costume and be prepared to tell a few facts about your saint so others can guess who you are.
