* <u>EASTER DUTY</u> *

All the faithful who have reached the use of reason are gravely obliged to receive Holy Communion worthily at least once during the Easter season. In the United States, this extends from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (the Sunday after Pentecost).

- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> will be on May 25 after the 9:00 Mass. If you or your children are being confirmed, please fill out a form from the vestibule, and return to the slot in the counter before Easter. Thank you!
- <u>SPONSORS</u> must be of the same gender as the person being confirmed, and they must be *practicing traditional Catholics* who are already confirmed in the traditional rite.
- <u>BAPTISMAL CERTIFICATES</u> must be provided if our church does not already have your certificate from a previous sacrament received here. The original copies will be returned to you.
- <u>CONDITIONAL</u>: If any adult parishioners were confirmed in the Vatican II church around 1973 or after, and you have not yet been conditionally confirmed in the traditional rite, you may be conditionally confirmed on May 25. Please sign up ASAP, using the forms in the vestibule.
- <u>SCHOOL REGISTRATION</u>: If there will be any new students in Kindergarten next year, or if any parish families are considering coming to ICA (Immaculate Conception Academy) for the first time, please speak with Sr. Philomena by Easter so that classroom arrangements can be planned for next year. • FAQ / REVIEW ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- <u>CONTACT FIRST:</u> If coming to make a visit or do volunteer work at church outside of scheduled Mass or event times, parishioners are welcome to come (before 7 PM). But please contact one of the priests or sisters ahead of time to make sure someone will be available to let you in, and to make sure that there will be no baptism, wedding, etc. occurring at that time.
- **<u>BULLETIN</u>**: Please read the whole bulletin every week, as not all the announcements are read on the pulpit. When you are out of town or not able to make it to Sunday Mass, please look up the bulletin online.
- If coming from a distance during the week, please check the online bulletin to see if any weekday Masses have been canceled for a funeral. Any changes will be posted in the online bulletin in red.
- **PARISH WEBSITE ADDRESS** is in the bulletin. Please explore so you know what resources are available.
- Sermons and retreat talks are often posted on the sermons tab. Past years' Lenten retreats are still posted.
- <u>VISITING</u>: Between Sunday Masses, please visit in Becket Hall or outside in order not to disturb those praying in church and in the cry room/vestibule.
- <u>ITEMS TO BE BLESSED, & THE LOST AND FOUND/ CLAIMS COUNTER</u> is in the parish hall. Items to be blessed may be placed on the left side of the claims counter. Write <u>your name and "Please bless"</u> on the packaging (bag or box...), and Father will mark it as blessed and leave it on this counter to be picked up.
- <u>Please</u> go through your families' bags of prayer books and church things to see if one of your children accidentally picked up someone else's prayer book. Parishioners are still missing Missals that are not appearing on the lost and found counter. Please label all of your own books that you bring to church.
- <u>CONTACT</u>: Please remember that cell phones are the best way for parishioners to contact the priests or sisters, as the landline messages are not checked as frequently. The priests' **contact information** is at the top of the bulletin.
- **IN EMERGENCY**, if the priests do not answer their cell phones, try calling the landline more than once.
