- <u>ASCENSION THURSDAY</u> is May 29. The faithful are reminded that they are bound under pain of mortal sin to attend Mass and to abstain from any unnecessary work or shopping, just as on Sundays.
- <u>RECEPTION</u>: There will be an opportunity to visit with Fr. Molina after the three Masses on Ascension Thursday. Please feel free to bring finger food to share, and stay to visit with Father after one of the Masses on Thursday, May 29. Masses will be at 7 AM, 9 AM, and 6 PM.

- <u>CONFIRMATION</u> will be after the 9:00 Mass on Sunday, May 25. Girls and ladies are encouraged to wear a white and/or red dress, if possible. White veils with red flowers will be provided for the girls to borrow. Red ties will be available for boys to borrow. You will be able to find these items before the 9:00 Mass on May 25 in the meeting room across from the elevator. Please plan to be early, especially if you would like to get in line for confession.
- The front pew on each side will be reserved for those confirmandi and sponsors who would like to sit up front. All confirmandi and sponsors should be ready to come up to the Communion rail immediately after the 9:00 Mass.
- <u>POTLUCK</u> on May 25 will be after the 7 AM & 9 AM Masses, and there will also be Confirmation cake after the Confirmation ceremonies following the 9:00 Mass.
- <u>SUMMER CATECHISM</u> will be June 9 13, lasting from after the 8 AM Mass until noon. The bishop will not be coming this year, but Fr. Craig will have classes for adults and there will be visiting sisters covering all the age groups through high school.
