Saint Clotilda, grandmother of Saint Cloud (June 3)

Clotilda was given in marriage to Clovis when he was still a pagan... The queen continued to exhort her husband to reject idolatry and to adore the One God; Clovis, however, persisted in the superstitions of the Franks, until at length, being on an expedition against the Alamani, and one day seeing his army waver, he remembered the counsels of Clotilda, and implored the help of Christ, who thereupon granted him victory. Saint Remigius instructed Clovis in the faith, and baptized him, anointing him likewise with the sacred chrism...

After the death of Clovis, Clotilda settled herself at Tours, where she passed the rest of her life at the tomb of Saint Martin, giving herself up to watching, alms, and other works of piety, exercising her munificence upon churches and monasteries. (From *The Liturgical Year*, by Dom Gueranger)
